# Covid-19 Update

## A message from the GM:

Covid 19 has been a real challenge for us all. TCBA has been in lockdown like the rest of the country with staff working from home and waiting for the confirmation we can start on court activities again. During this time staff have still been busy, doing all the things that we never quite get too, plus preparing for when we can get back to playing again.

One thing that is ongoing is our lobbying of Councils for more facilities and to keep costs for using council facilities to a minimum. Part of this process are submissions to the annual plan process. Tauranga City Council's submissions are open until the 3 May. TCBA annually present to Council, but this year we are also asking our members to also put in a submission. This is due to the proposed hike in court hire rates by Bay Venues. It is currently proposed that court costs will rise on average about 25%. TCBA is not in a position to absorb this, so the fees we charge for all our programmes (leagues, trainings etc) would need to rise by at least this figure. This means you will need to pay at least 25% more for the same activity you were involved in before. Submissions can be done online at
