Tournament Rules and Format

All teams will be playing full FIBA basketball rules with the following tournament rules

Game duration: 2 x 15 min stop clock halves; 2 minutes at half time

Tied Game: In the event of tied scores, a further three minutes will be played to determine a winner

Time Outs: One 60 sec time out per half

Personal Fouls: 5 personal fouls per game

Team Fouls: 6 team fouls per half before being in the penalty (shooting on the 7th foul)

Scorebench: We will endeavor to cover most games. You may be asked to help if required.

First Division Players: Only 2 current first division players per team allowed

Uniform Clash: In the event of teams having the same colour uniforms Team A on the scoresheet will be expected to change into an alternative colour.

Uniform Numbers: Uniforms with numbers back and front are expected

Match Ball: Teams are to provide their own match ball (size 6 for women; size 7 for men)

Warm Up: Teams will be given at least 5 minutes for warm up

Scoresheets: Teams to complete their first scoresheet 10 minutes prior to the start of their first game. These will be available from the Tournament Control room. All other scoresheets will be completed by the tournament organizers

Game Start Time: Games will start to time. 5 players must be ready to take the court at the designated start time. If 5 players are not ready to take the court five minutes after the designated start time then a default will occur

ID: Proof of age may be requested

First Aid Kit: Teams are expected to have their own first aid kit. Ice is available from venue controllers

Prizegiving: Will take place at the ASB Arena after the finals on Sunday.
